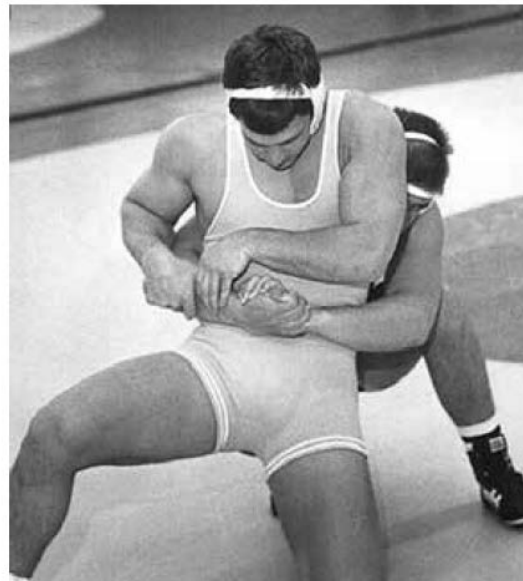


**Article #3 Rules Book Correction

This communication is to provide an official correction to an error found in the 2019-21 Wrestling Rules Book.

1. This correction is found on page 93 photograph #68 copied below. This picture displays a scenario in which the wrestler is locking hands since the defensive wrestler has weight supported on the one knee shown in the photo. The word NOT is to be stricken.

No. 68—INTERLOCKING OF HANDS
AROUND THE BODY. *A technical viola-
tion. Offensive wrestler is not allowed to
lock (overlap) hands, fingers, wrists or arms
around body while defensive wrestler is sup-
ported by parts other than feet. This is ~~no~~
considered locking hands since the weight is
not supported by the feet.*
