SUBJECT: 2018-19 NCAA Wrestling Registration and Referee Clinics.

The NCAA wrestling rules exam and video will be available online beginning 8 a.m. Eastern time, Friday, September 14 and closing at 5 p.m. Eastern time, Friday, October 19. Chuck Barbee, secretary-rules editor, will review new rules and points of emphasis for the upcoming season.

Each referee assigned to NCAA wrestling competition is required to annually pass the online exam and view the rules presentation. This year's exam will have questions from both the 2018-19 Rules Book and Case Book. The NCAA Wrestling Case Book is the new home for all wrestling interpretations and can be found on the Center Mat website under the rules book tab.

All referees who wish to be eligible to officiate NCAA wrestling competition will be required to register on the ArbiterSports [website](#) and complete the online exam and view the rules video by October 19. ArbiterSports is the official site for NCAA wrestling referees. The site will house the annual rules exam, a downloadable rules book and case book, video clips, teaching materials, post-season assignments, ejection forms, updated officials' mechanics information from Mr. Shiels, as well as interpretations and points of emphasis from Mr. Barbee.
