

NEWS & NOTES

Officials, as we get ready for the 2021-22 wrestling season, please note the following:

- September 10th – This is the first day to re-register for the upcoming season. All officials must register and pass the open book test with a score of 86 or better (2 attempts).
- NEW – To be eligible for post-season, you must score 90 or better on the test.

Registration fees for the upcoming season:

- Division I - \$175
- Division II - \$150
- Division III - \$125
- Evaluators/Observers - \$85
- 1st Year NCAA Officials - \$50 – 1st year fees of \$50 apply only to officials entering college officiating for the first time.

Register under the Division of where you officiate the most dates. Officials who officiate a Division I Conference Championship must register as a Division I official. NAIA and JUCO officials must register under the Division III category.

- The National Wrestling Officials Association (NWOA) Summit sponsored by the ICWOA, BIG 10 and BIG 12 Conferences will be held October 8th – 10th in Tulsa, OK. The National Conference is for all officials. For additional information, check ICWOA.org.
- Please don't wait until the last minute to take the mandatory officiating test! The deadline to take and pass the test is Tuesday, October 19th at 5:00pm (EST). NO EXCEPTIONS!!

NEW – A much requested Officiating Handbook and Mechanics Manual will be available to download for the upcoming season. Whether you're a new official or a veteran, the Officiating Handbook will prove to be invaluable.
