

RESPONSIBILITIES OF 3RD PARTY/INDEPENDENT REVIEWER

1. Verify with your Assignment Coordinator, 3-4 days prior to the competition, that the host school has cleared you at the pass gate.
2. Upon arrival at the site, introduce yourself to the Head Scorer, Timekeeper, Riding Time Operator and Host Management.
3. Meet with the video specialist, review where you'll be located, camera angles, location of match and riding time clocks, and all information pertinent to video review challenges.
4. Introduce yourself to both Head Coaches, when they're on the competition site. Do not go to the locker rooms. Answer any questions/concerns they may have – discussions should be brief.
5. Meet briefly at the Head Table with the match official to discuss procedure if there is a coach's challenge, or if the official wants to review his own call.
6. Coaches must toss out the red or green foam brick and clearly state to the Independent Reviewer, and the official what they're challenging. The official will inform the PA announcer what is being challenged, and the announcer or official (if no announcer is present) will inform the fans.
7. **ONLY** the match official will review a call they've requested on themselves.
8. **ONLY** the Independent Reviewer will review coach's challenges. While this is taking place, the official will be on the mat making certain wrestlers are in their team corners on the mat, and that coaches are in their reserved zones.
9. The Independent Reviewer will review the call being challenged, make his/her decision, and inform the official that either the call stands, the call is confirmed, or the call is overturned.

10. The official will inform the PA announcer if present, the decision of the Independent Reviewer. The announcer or official will inform the fans. Note: If the call has been overturned, the official will confer with the timekeeper, eliminate “bad time” wrestled, re-set the clock and re-start the wrestlers.
11. The official, not the Independent Reviewer, will determine if a coach’s challenge was done without delay and will be reviewed.
