



**Chuck Barbee SRE Article #8
Rules Book Corrections**

Please note the following corrections which as of this publication become the official language in the 2019-20 and 2020-21 NCAA Wrestling Rules Book. These changes are also logged in the Rules Book correction document found in in the rules information section of this website.

Rule 3.8.2 Determining Wrestling Order; Multiple Dual Meets at Different Sites: While there are no more dual meets for the 2019-20 season, this correction will be in place for the 2020-21 dual meet season.

Art. 2. Multiple Dual Meets at Different Sites. When multiple dual meets are wrestled on the same day at different sites, the order of matches to be wrestled at the second site will be decided by mutual agreement or a coin toss (see Rule 3.8.1) conducted by the coaches not ~~more~~ **less** than two hours prior to the start of competition.

Rule 5.6.14 Figure-Four Scissors: The words highlighted in yellow are to be added to this rule.

Art. 14 Figure-Four Scissors. The figure-four scissors is illegal when applied by either wrestler around the body of the opponent, by the offensive wrestler around both legs of the defensive wrestler, or by **either** the defensive wrestler around the head, with or without the arm included, **or on the head** while in a neutral position **by either wrestler.**

SRE Comment: Adding this language ultimately states that the figure four is only legal when applied on the head by the offensive wrestler.
