Location of error: the penalty table on page 55.

Correction issued: correction to the penalty sequence for illegal holds.

Illegal holds are not considered technical violations; however, they are penalized in the technical violation sequence on the penalty table.

For example: if a wrestler is charged, on two separate occasions, for committing a technical violation, and then applies a full nelson on the wrestler; the wrestler would be penalized 2 points for the illegal hold since there were two previous technical violations that occurred prior to the illegal hold. For any illegal hold, if the affected wrestler is unable to continue, after recovery time, then the opposing wrestler loses by disqualification.
